Home Help

Practise reading daily with your child. See which sounds your child can recognise in the words in the story.

Take the opportunity to count daily with your child. Remember to count forwards and backwards to build numerical fluency.

Our Learning Summary

Literacy

We have been learning our initial sounds through Letterland are beginning to use our knowledge of these to blend and build words in reading and writing.

We have been working on the Teaching Children to Listen programme with Miss Millar, our Speech and Language Therapist. We have learned the four rules of good listening and refer to these daily in class.

Numeracy & Maths

We have been learning about number through Numberblocks. We have been introduced to numbers 1 - 6 and have used our understanding of these numbers to recognise dot patterns on a dice.

We have participated in our school's Money Fortnight. We have learned about the different coins that we use in our country and can identify each one. We are beginning to be able to add small amounts together to create a given total.

Health & Wellbeing

We worked together as a class to create our Class Charter which emphasises the rights we have in class and how we can access these rights in a kind and safe manner. We have been learning about the different Health and Wellbeing indicators and how we demonstrate them in our lives. We have focused this term on safe, healthy and achieving.
