Our Learning Summary

<u>Literacy</u>

- Developing reading strategies focus on Predicting, Questioning, Clarifying and Summarising
- Novel study "The Boy at the Back of the Class" – linked learning around issues within this story
- Writing Persuasive Genre writing an exposition (one-sided argument), focusing on correct layout and recommended language. During Book Week Scotland, writing a story set in the future
- Listening & Talking throughout the curriculum
- Grammar consistent and correct use
- Use French in everyday routines and recall learned vocabulary with increasing confidence. Our focus this term will be Greetings, Weather, the Calendar, Colours and Personal Information
- Spelling focus on accurate spelling in all areas and learning new patterns and rules <u>Numeracy & Mathematics</u>
 - Estimating and Rounding numbers
 - Data Handling interpreting information from a table, bar graph or pictograph. Carrying out a simple survey, displaying results
 - Identifying a line of symmetry and creating a symmetrical shape accurately
 - Identifying the position of an object on a coordinate grid
 - Recognising and naming 2d and 3d shapes and their properties (Shape Weeks focus)
