Our Learning Summary

Literacy

Primary One will be introduced to all of the sounds in the alphabet through our Letterland resource this term. We will begin to blend these sounds together to read and write simple words. We will also be focusing on recognising and writing our names. Pupils will be introduced to 5 new High Frequency Words each week to build sight recognition. We will begin to read group reading books daily and discuss the character, setting and vocabulary.

Numeracy & Maths

Primary One will be focusing on number recognition, sequencing and counting. We are learning to confidently count forwards and backwards, recognise the number before/ after and practice our number formation.

We will be participating in our school's Money Fortnight. We are learning to identify the different coins that we use in our country and state their value.

Health & Wellbeing

Primary 1 are focusing on school routines and safety in our classroom and our school. We are working together as a class to create our Class Charter. Our charter emphasises the rights we have in class and how we can access these rights in a kind and safe way.

We will begin to learn about emotions.

In PE, Primary 1 will be focusing on space and movement through various activities.
