Our Learning Summary

<u>Literacy</u> – We are looking forward to reading different novels with our reading groups this term. We will develop our use of reciprocal reading strategies as well as working on reading with expression and with greater fluency. We will be working on expanding our vocabulary with Word Boost this term which will allow us to extend our writing. We will be learning the key features of narrative and descriptive writing this term, and we are excited to begin writing our own stories.

Numeracy & Maths – In maths this term we will be learning all about time. We will learn how to read and interpret timetables as well as about 12 and 24 hour clocks. We will also be learning about collecting data and the different ways we can display and interpret information. We will continue to improve our knowledge and recall of times table facts and linking this knowledge to division. We are continuing to build our confidence in using a range of strategies to solve addition and subtraction problems through our daily Number Talks sessions.

Health & Wellbeing – In Health and Wellbeing we are continuing to identify ways to demonstrate our school values of kindness, perseverance and success. We will be learning about our emotions and will consider the importance of mental health during our focus week. This term we will be continuing to work with our Wellbeings, focusing on achievement and responsibility. We are excited to learn about lots of different skills and how these are relevant to different careers and consider which jobs we might like to do in future. We will be learning about Fair Trade coffee and the impact that Fair Trade has on the lives of coffee producers.

Interdisciplinary Learning – For the first part of the term we will be learning about Scotland and in particular looking at the life and work of the inventor James Watt. We will then move onto learning all about different natural disasters and how the occur as well as considering the impact that these have on both people and the environment.
