
Need & When...

### Our Learning Summary

Literacy – We are reading novels with our groups this term. We will continue to use reciprocal reading strategies and develop reading fluency and expression. We are expanding our vocabulary with Word Boost again this term and we will be able to use our learning in our writing. We will be learning the key features of narrative and descriptive writing and we are excited to be writing our own imaginative stories.

<u>Numeracy & Maths</u> – Our focus week this term is time. We will learn to read and interpret timetables as well as 12 and 24 hour clocks. We will be learning about data collection and different ways we can display and interpret information. We will continue to work on times table facts and division and we will also be learning about fractions. We are continuing to build our confidence using a range of strategies to solve problems through our daily Number Talks sessions.

<u>Health & Wellbeing</u> We will continue to demonstrate our school values of kindness, perseverance and success. We will be learning about emotions and mental health during our focus week. We will continue to work with our Wellbeings focusing on achievement and responsibility. We will be linking our learning and skills to The World of Work finding out more about different careers and jobs. During Fairtrade fortnight we will be learning about coffee and the impact that Fair Trade has on the lives of coffee producers.

Interdisciplinary Learning We will start the term learning about Scotland and finding out about the life and work of the inventor James Watt. We will move onto learning about different natural disasters, how they occur and how they impact on people and the environment.
