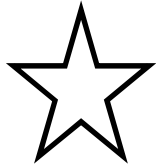


# P3/2 Home Learning

## Literacy

## Skills for Learning Life and Work

## Numeracy and Maths



We have been learning strategies for subtraction. Create your own number line and use it to subtract by counting backwards. Ask an adult to write you some number sentences with missing numbers to solve. Remember to use our strategies!

Can you practise skip counting in 2s, 5s and 10s with your child at home?

Can you describe the properties of 2D shapes and 3D objects? Go on a shape hunt with an adult at home!



## Creativity

Continue to look for signs of Winter in your community. Can you make a nature picture using some of the frosty materials you find?

Take photographs of different 2D and 3D shapes you find outside. Can you use them to make a picture?
