Numeracy and Maths



Use the numerals in the year 1759 and 1796 try create as many calculations as possible. Try to include as many of the four operations as you can?

Look for a recipe for haggis, neeps and tatties try to recreate it using the same measurements.

Play this game with another person. One person writes down a 3-digit 'total' number. The other person writes down four numbers between 1 and 10 as well as three numbers which are multiples of 10, up to 100. e.g. Total: 437 Numbers: 4, 7, 9, 3, 20, 70, 50 Set a two-minute timer and work out the total number by using the other numbers and any operations, e.g. +, -, ÷ and x. The person closest to the total number wins.
