Breakfast Club



Breakfast Club will begin on **Tuesday 13th August** and will run each morning from 8:15 am.

Children will receive breakfast and have the opportunity to play outside before going to the classroom.

Children must enter via the courtyard door in the upper area of the playground. Members of staff will support children to the door and register them.

Please note children cannot enter Breakfast Club via the School Office.

School Lunch



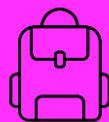
Pupils in P1-5 receive free school meals. Children can bring a packed lunch if they wish to do so.

Pupils can order their lunch in the morning with their teacher. You can also order your child's school lunch via IPAY.

Belongings & Bags

School bags can be brought to school to carry belongings such as lunch boxes and water bottles.



Children should not bring any personal items or toys.

It is important that children bring their own labelled water bottle to school. We don't encourage juice. Bottles should be taken home daily.



School Milk



The table below shows the cost of milk for the year 2024-2025. Payment for milk can now be made online using iPayimpact.

The price per carton is maintained at a low level due to the milk subsidy received from the European Union Milk Subsidy Scheme which may change soon.

Children in Primary 1 – Primary 5 receive free school meals through the Scottish Government Scheme, if your child is entitled to free school milk, you will still need to apply for this through the free school meals scheme.

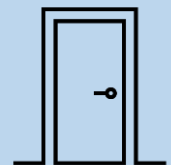

What Time and What Door Will My Child Come In/Leave By?



All children not attending Breakfast Club should enter via any school gate and walk around to the playground. Until the September Holiday, P1 parents only can bring their child into the playground. When the bell sounds at **8:55 am**, P2-7 pupils should come into school via the main area doors. Staff will be there to support.

At the end of the school day, all parents can enter the playground from 3:15 pm and wait outside their child's classroom door. Children will be dismissed on the bell at **3:20 pm**, Monday to Thursday. On a Friday, parents can enter the playground at 12:25 pm and pupils will be dismissed at **12:30 pm**.
