It was great to see the children take ownership of this event, doing the bingo calling etc. The children have voted for innoflate and P7 children carried out the research and costed the outing. The event includes food (nachos, hot dogs and pizza) and unlimited squash. This is an exclusive hire.</li> <li>The P7 party has also been fundraised for and full costs covered.</li> <li>A parent has also raised some money for the P7 events in their local community. 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estimated that between up to £1500 - £2000 was raised with all this.	
Mosswood Community Centre	
All westlothian community centres are being reviewed. This includes Mosswood which means that they may be subject to an asset transfer or something else. This was discussed because the school decided not to request any funds. It is better for Mosswood to be supporting their local community.	
School Trips	
School trips are very expensive and just to hire a bus to transport kids to and from an activity can be in excess of £1000. This year the school planned a whole school trip to the cinema.	
Next year there will be P6 outdoor adventures and P7 residentials. There is discussion about curricular related trips. For example, outings to a castle.	
The school has also arranged for people to come in to do activities with children, for example, Authors, people in to do coding.	
The school are also taking part in some research with Cambridge University who are researching pupils experiences in accessing microbits. This is also in connection with the BBC. This has resulted in the school being given some funding.	
PEF Funding – part of this has to go to participatory budgeting. The students requested this be used to fund some additional digital technology.	
Next year – there are a group of P6's working on some plans for what this might be used for next year. There have been some ideas around equity, cost of the school day etc. Some ideas are	

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	around school trips, family clubs etc.	
	There was also a national school choir who were working with P4's. Some children also took part in a dance competition.	
	The school has a link with a book shop who are good at helping them arrange authors to visit.	
	The recent sports day was a success. This was the first sports day the school has had that parents could attend since 2019 due to COVID and then the school closures.	
	The P7 assembly is on Tuesday 25 <sup>th</sup> . The school will get in touch with families to let them know how many family members can come.	
	P1 transitions have gone really well. P1's has come in for lunch. Parents are coming in for tea and coffee and everything has gone really well.
