


<u>Knightsridge Primary School</u> <u>Primary 4/3 Newsletter</u> – *Term 2*

Our Learning Summary

<u>Literacy</u> – We are using our talking and listening skills to help us to work more independently in reading groups and other small group tasks. We will be reading a range of texts and information reports and continuing to develop our fluency and phrasing.

This term we will be writing information reports and learning to take notes to record information. We will continue to apply our spelling strategies and use our 'tools for writing' to further develop our independence when writing.

Numeracy & Maths –

In Numeracy, we will be developing our number knowledge using addition and subtraction and times tables. We will be developing knowledge of mental maths strategies through Number Talks and applying our number knowledge to real life contexts. We are growing in confidence when explaining our strategies and will continue to build on this success. We will be learning about 2D and 3D shapes using correct vocabulary to describe their properties.

<u>Health & Wellbeing</u> We are continuing to develop our knowledge of emotions thinking about behaviours and regulation strategies and using the Zones of Regulation in class. Our Wellbeing characters will help us to learn more about being 'Safe' and 'Included' and we will continue to demonstrate our school values of kindness perseverance and success through our Diversity, Road Safety and Anti-Bullying focus weeks this term.
