Literacy

Reading – We will read non-fiction texts and continue to apply the reciprocal reading strategies. This will help to develop our knowledge of different language features.

Writing – This term we will create information reports, following the clear structure and language features specific to this genre.

Listening & Talking – Primary 5 will use digital technology to research and identify reliable
