Our Learning Summary

In Literacy this term, our focus will continue to be on our Core Writing Targets. We will also continue with Spelling. For Writing, we will be learning how to write to persuade, and we will get the opportunity to choose our topics to write about. We will learn all about different persuasive techniques that can be used to influence a reader. Linked to this, we will be reading persuasive texts, and will consider how to tell the difference between fact and opinion and how to tell if a source is reliable. We will be taking part in debates for Listening and Talking, and are excited to do this!

Numeracy & Maths

In Numeracy and Maths, we will be revising strategies for the Four Operations, including using these to solve problems with Decimals, linking this to Money. We will also be learning about the properties of Shape, including Angles. We will look at how to calculate Area, and have already begun calculating Perimeter. As we move through the term, we will begin to look at Coordinates, as well as looking at reading and creating different graphs.

Health & Wellbeing

In Health and Wellbeing, we will be focusing on the indicators Safe and Included. As part of this, we will consider how to stay safe during events such as Bonfire Night as well as considering Online Safety. We plan also to work with our buddies on Road Safety. As part of our learning about Included, we will learn about Diversity and take part in Anti-Bullying Week. In P.E., we will focus on fitness.
