MULTIPLICATION TABLES AWARDS

The following awards can be made to individual pupils when tested by teachers on recall and knowledge of multiplication tables.

BRONZE

For being able to say a complete multiplication table to a teacher without error or long pauses (self corrections may be made).

e.g. "Two times one is two, two times two is four...."

SILVER

For being able to give the products of numbers multiplied together out of table sequence.
e.g. Question "What are four fives?" Answer "Twenty"
(i.e. Random order questions).

GOLD

For being able to give multiplication facts when provided with the product only.
e.g. Question "Fifty-six?" Answer "Seven eights / eight sevens"
Also being able to answer to the following....
e.g. Question "Twenty-four divided by six?" Answer "Four"
(i.e. Random order questions).
